

## **COVID PROTOCOLS FOR YOUTH PROGRAMS, DANCE AND OTHER CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS**

1. Workers, children, parents, and caregivers must not enter the building if they have symptoms of COVID-19 or have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days.
2. Registration lists including name and contact information will be maintained for all programs.
3. Parents and caregivers will confirm they understand how-to complete a health check for their children. Parents will agree to complete the health check daily. A signed agreement will be submitted prior to start of program.
  - a. If the health check is completed and a question(s) answered with "yes", parents and caregivers must keep their children at home until they have been assessed by a health care provider to exclude COVID-19 or other infectious diseases, and their symptoms have resolved.
  - b. Parents & caregivers confirm that by dropping off their child they have completed the daily health check and answered "no" to all questions.
4. Parents and caregivers will drop-off their children at the "The Back Door" entrance where the child will check-in with the instructor.
5. Children will exit via a designated exit indicated by their instructor. When picking up their child, parents and caregivers will wait outside the designated exit door.
6. Children being picked up by their parent or caregiver will be accompanied to their designated exit door, (usually by their instructor).
7. It is not recommended that parents or caregivers be in the building during their children's program, however, if they must, only one parent or caregiver should enter and when in the lobby or hallway, should wear a mask.
8. It is not recommended that parents or caregivers wait in the building for their children, however if they must, that person should wait in the hallway and wear a mask while there.
9. Everyone should maintain physical distance from others and practice hand hygiene.
10. Should a child develop symptoms associated with COVID-19 while in the building, the parent or caregiver will be asked to come immediately for pickup. While awaiting pickup, that child will be isolated, provided a mask and asked to wash their hands.
11. Public health will be notified regarding any potential cases where staff assess to have found to symptoms for COVID-19.
12. Krush Dance will not provide notification to staff or children's families if a staff member or child becomes ill, including if they display symptoms of COVID-19, UNLESS otherwise directed to by public health.
